The So-Called Reproductive Justice and Access Act

In the Illinois General Assembly, Representative **Barbara Flynn Currie** (D-Chicago) has recently introduced House Bill 6205, known as the Reproductive and Justice Access Act. Planned Parenthood's political apparatus has begun an intensive push to pass this legislation.

The enactment of House Bill 6205 would:

- Gut the Illinois Parental Notice of Abortion Act;
- Require taxpayers to fund abortions through Medicaid;
- Eliminate Illinois' Health Care Right of Conscience Act;
- Mandate comprehensive sex education for every student in Illinois public schools, kindergarten through 12.
