Federal candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:

- 1 | H.R. 26 Born Alive Abortion Survivors Act (2023) requires the same medical care be provided to an infant born alive after surviving an attempted abortion as any other baby at that gestational age.
- 2 | H. Con. Res. 3 (2023) condemns attacks and vandalism against pro-life organizations and churches.
- 3 | H.R. 734 (2023) Protection of Women and Girls in Sports Act prevents biological males from competing against biological females.
- 4 | H.R. 2670, Am. No. 5 (2023) prohibits the U.S. Department of Defense from paying for or reimbursing expenses related to abortion.
- 5 | H.R. 2670 Am. No. 35 (2023) would prohibit subjecting children in military-funded schools to books containing pornographic content and/or a positive portrayal of gender identity.
- 6 | H.R. 2670 National Defense Authorization Act (Roll Call 328-2023) focuses on the military’s true mission and reins in the Biden administration’s efforts to promote abortion and transgender ideology.
- 7 | H.R. 5 Parents Bill of Rights (2023) safeguards the right of parents to view curriculum, books, and reading materials at school; requires parent’s consent for a school to change gender markers.
- 8 | H.Res. 771 (2023) declares that the U.S. House stands with Israel, calls on Hamas to immediately cease the brutal war and to release hostages and bodies of deceased hostages.
- 9 | H.R. 2 (2023) would reinstate the Trump Administration border security measures by resuming construction of the border wall, hiring more border patrol agents, and ending the “catch-and-release” of foreign nationals into our country.
- 10 | H.R. 4664 Am. No. 54 defunds the plans to build a new FBI building for \$3.5 billion.

State candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:

- A | HB 4664 Am 5 (2022): Allows anyone who has lost medical license/certification in another state to perform abortions in IL and prohibits insurance companies from denying coverage for “reproductive” care under that person.

B | HB 9 (2021): allows a person to change their birth certificate gender to male, female, or X as many times as they want.

C | SB 1720 (2021): lawmakers gave themselves an 18% pay raise, bringing their part-time base salary to \$85,000.

D | HB 1286 (2023) multiple-occupancy public restrooms can now be co-ed.

E | HB 2039 (2023) Allows all private health data be made available to local health departments “for the purposes of preventing or controlling disease, injury, or disability” and “any rules necessary to implement the Act” to be created.

F | SB 1909 (2023) allows the Attorney General to investigate and fine pregnancy care centers for ads or information that conflict with the Attorney General’s views.

G | SB 1344 (2023) mandates abortifacient and transgender hormone therapy coverage in all Illinois insurance policies.
- H | HB 2350 (2023) mandates insurance companies pay for prostate exams for women and pap tests for men.

I | HB 1591 (2023) repealed 3 marriage statutes in conflict with same-sex “marriage.”

J | HB 1596 (2023) replaces gender-specific pronouns in dozens of state statutes with gender-neutral nouns.

K | HB 2248 (2023) fines of \$4K for causing “emotional distress” against LGBTQ and others.

L | HB 2789 (2023) prohibits restricting or removing objectionable books from all libraries.

M | SB 1463 (2023) removes all fines, penalties, fees for those 18 and younger who break the law.

N | HB 2392 (2023) allows teachers to spend 10 days of the school year on union-related activities.

O | HB 3751 (2023) allows a non-citizen to be a police officer.

P | SB 423 (2023) revises parole policies by reducing certain supervision requirements of criminals.
